MD vision



Macular degeneration (MD) refers to a group of degenerative diseases of the retina that cause progressive, painless loss of central vision, affecting the ability to see fine detail, drive, read and recognise faces.

Dry MD is caused by the build up of deposits in the layer under the retina with time, and can lead to thinning of the central retina and gradual loss of central vision.

Wet MD is characterised by a sudden loss of vision and is caused by abnormal growth of blood vessels into the retina.

Cataracts

Cataracts affect around half of Australians aged between over 65 to 74. A cataract is a cloudy area in the lens of the eye that interferes with vision by diffusing light as it passes through the eye.

Low vision aids

Magnifying spectacles and magnifying aids can assist patients with poor vision.


